An SMS to allow replacement of teachers

USPA NEWS - During the school year 2014, nearly 500 children had no teacher in the classroom the first day of school. Thanks to the efforts of all, the return in 2015 was much better place. But non-replacements are then multiplied throughout the year.

After the summer and during the entire school year, a free SMS notification service is set up to allow us to accurately account for substitute teachers needs. Elected officials, parents, teachers, Dionysian will, every teacher of non-replacement, send an SMS to 32321 (free service, no surcharge), using the following model: "Not replaced - Name of the school - Class concerned
